We are very excited that you are considering serving on our Children's Ministry Team. Our team is comprised of many different roles that utilize a wide array of gifts and interests. This information sheet is intended to help you take the next step toward serving with us on our Children's Ministry Team.

WHAT WE ARE ALL ABOUT

Our Children's Ministry team is passionate about showing and teaching our children the love of Christ, helping them to know and love Him more, and teaching them to live by Biblical principles and truths. In our nursery, preschool, and grade school classrooms, we engage our children in age appropriate activities in the areas of music, drama, games, crafts, Bible study, and team-building.

UNIQUE WAYS TO SERVE

Here are some of the roles you can play on our team:

- **Check-in** – Greet and register guests and members, manage security tag system.
- **Nursery Teacher** – Care for and teach our youngest children, ages 3 -35 months.
- **Preschool Lead Teacher** – Plan and lead stories, centers, and music for children ages 3-5 years.
- **Preschool Assistant Teacher** - Assist the lead teacher with stories, centers, and music for children ages 3-5 years.
- **Grade School Lead Teacher** – Plan, prepare, and lead small group activities for children ages Kinder – 5th grade.
- **Grade School Assistant Teacher** – Assist the lead teacher in small group activities for children ages Kinder–5th grade.
- **Coordinator** – Oversee the activity flow during Bibleland time. Provide resources for teachers and families.
- **Large Group Host/Storyteller** – Bring Bible stories to life for our grade school children.
- **5th Grade Worship Team Leader** – Select and teach worship songs and plan choreography for our 5th grade worship team.
- **Weekday Supply Organizer** – Help in the office for 1-2 hours per week with supplies and special projects.
- **Outreach Manager** – Contact new families and help connect them to our ministry and our church.
