I. Job Summary:

Provide quality audio mix for services so that Christ can be displayed to those in our community.

II. <u>Primary Duties and Responsibilities</u>:

- 1. Mix live audio signals for worship services and supporting rehearsals.

- 3. Communicate input/stage plot changes to the Campus Producer and Broadcast Engineer.
- 4. Adhere to OHC Sound Management Covenant Standards.
- 5. Work with other audio engineers on a rotating schedule.

III. <u>Minimum Qualifications:</u>

- 1. High School Degree or equivalent.
- 2. Two (2) to three (3) years of experience with audio concepts and signal flow, digital mixing and processing techniques or related experience.
