FAMILY STUDY

This Week

Use the following resource to engage with God as a family.

Read THE STORY Chapter 27: The Resurrection in The Story for Little Ones/Children/Kids

Do Together:

Help your child remember the story from the last two weeks and the new life that we can have through Jesus with these Easter eggs that tell the story of Jesus' death and resurrection. Gather plastic Easter eggs or other small containers. Put things inside each egg that remind you of a part of the Bible story. You might use the following items: a piece of bread, a rock, a strip of cloth, spices, a small cross, a nail, a plastic flower, and a piece of string or rope. Leave one of the eggs empty. Number the outside of the eggs to go in order of the story. The last egg is the empty egg. As you open each egg, retell that part of the Bible story. When you get to the empty egg, celebrate that the women found Jesus' tomb empty because he was risen!

Talk About:

- 1. Tell me something amazing that happened to you.
- 2. What amazing thing happened to Jesus?
- 3. Jesus' friends were surprised when they found his empty tomb. Have you ever been surprised?

FAMILY STUDY

Use the following resource to engage with God as a family.

Read THE STORY Chapter 27: The Resurrection in The Story for Little Ones/Children/Kids

Do Together:

Help your child remember the story from the last two weeks and the new life that we can have through Jesus with these Easter eggs that tell the story of Jesus' death and resurrection.
