- 2. Ponder some times where you *did* heed God's Word, even though it was a difficult situation... What was the positive that came out of your obedience?**
- 3. What is something else from this story that stuck out to me? How can I share that with my family as we seek to grow as disciples?**



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## FAMILY STUDY

Use the following resource to engage with God as a family.

### Talk About

- \* Do you like it when your parents warn you about your behavior?
- \* Do you usually change your behavior before you get in trouble?
- \* God's people got in big trouble. Do you think that was fair?

**Do Together:** *Witness and Tell*

WHAT YOU NEED:

Optional: Fake microphone (to be given to kids as they speak)

WHAT YOU DO:

Have kids share a time they took the blame for something bad they didn't do. Why were they willing to take the blame? Or have them share a time when someone else took the blame for something bad they did.

**Pray Together:** *Dear God, thank you so much for sending Jesus as our savior. Even though we continue to mess things up, you still love us with an amazing love. Help us as we struggle with sin. Forgive us when we give in to temptation, and remind us that your love never fades. In Jesus name we pray. AMEN.*

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
