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This Week

Use the following resource to engage with God as a family this week.

Read Chapter 10: *Messages from God* in *The Story for Little Ones/Children/Kids*

Talk About

1. Have you ever made a promise so big that you didn't want to keep it? What did you do?
2. God let Samuel anoint Saul to be king. If you were king, what decisions would you make? Would you order dessert to be eaten before dinner? Would you outlaw tests at school?

Do Together

Play the "Calling to Service" game. Have the children line up at the far end of the room. Then call each one by name. If you say the name twice, the child can take a full step toward you. If you say the name only once, they must remain still or be penalized. When called only once, for every step the child takes, he/she must step backward two steps. Repeat to the end of the game.

Think about: Talk about God's persistence when he calls. Use Samuel as an example. God called him three times before Samuel knew that it was God and not Eli calling. God continued to call a fourth time. Why do you think God was so persistent with Samuel? Why do you suppose he kept calling Samuel and didn't just forget it and call someone else?
