



PARENT STUDY

Individually this week, spend time reading Chapter 18 of *The Story* or Jeremiah 29, 30 and 31 and Daniel 6.

As you study, pray that God shows you things that encourage, challenge, enlighten, and spur you to a stronger faith in Him.

BY YOURSELF...

Use these simple questions and prompts to help you ponder and prepare to discuss this week's chapter with your family.

1. **Daniel had an unwavering trust in God, no matter the risk. On a scale of 1 ("I flee God at the first sign of...anything...") to 10 ("I AM DANIEL!"), how would you rate your trust in God? What might help you to get *one number higher* on that scale in the next year?**
2. **Think of a time when you solely relied on your faith in the Lord to endure through something risky (or, ask God to remind you of a time, if you are finding that a difficult task). Is this something that still encourages your faith today?**
3. **What is something else from this story that stuck out to me? How can I share that with my family as we seek to grow as disciples?**



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FAMILY STUDY

Use the following resource to engage with God as a family.

Read **THE STORY Chapter 18: *God Watches Over Daniel***
in *The Story for Little Ones/Children/Kids*

Talk About

- * Daniel prayed even though he knew it could cost him his life. What are some things you pray about?
- * King Darius knew Daniel served God. The king even said, “*You always serve your God faithfully. So may he save you*” (Daniel 6:16). Daniel showed King Darius true faith in God with his actions (by praying and trusting him for protection) without saying a word. What are some actions you can take to show others you serve the one true God?

Do Together: *Witness and Tell*

WHAT YOU NEED:

Optional: Fake microphone (to be given to family members as they speak)

WHAT YOU DO:

Let everyone tell about ways they have been tested, or ways in which they have had to stand up to the heat of persecution or trials because of their faith. It is especially helpful if an adult can begin sharing her/her own testimony.

Pray Together: *Lord, thank you for letting us meet Daniel and his amazing faith in You. Thank you for rescuing him so others could see Your power and love. Help us trust You just like Daniel did. AMEN.*

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
