

HONDURAS Casa De Ester Mission Trip

Trip Dates: January 12-19, 2019
Healing Ministry—For Women Only



Trip Details:
Total Trip Cost: \$1,800

Land Cost: \$900. All inclusive of meals, lodging, in-country transportations, insurance, interpreters, bottled water, sightseeing, ministry supplies, etc.

Airfare Cost: \$900 OHC MUST arrange all Airfare travel.

Place of Stay:
The team will stay at CDE. The Mission Home is located on the grounds of CDE, a short walk from the main house. Beds are bunk style, with restroom/shower, and a small kitchen area. We will take all our meals (all buffet style) with the CDE girls at the main house.

Trip Orientation/Meetings:
We will have several Team meetings prior to our trip. We will provide you with a Team Informational Packet at the 1st Team Meeting. Team Meetings are required and will focus on building team unity, learning about the culture of our designated country, discuss & plan for our in-country service.

Who are our “partners” in Tegucigalpa, Honduras?

OHC short term teams partner with Casa de Ester, located in Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

Michael grew up at Oak Hills Church; he and his wife, Valina, first traveled to Honduras in the May 2013 and began working there on mission in the Fall of the same year. In May 2015 they took over full ownership and leadership of the Casa de Ester ministry.



CDE provides physical, spiritual, and emotional support to 17+ young women who are victims of abuse. Additionally, they provide educational, vocational, and transition assistance to

these women. Through their work and God's healing they are able to transform the lives of the women of Honduras. In December 2016, the Perry's transitioned stateside to focus on building their ministry partnership network, along with fundraising. Today, they are part of CoreLuv, and continue to be involved with the operations of CDE and participate with STM teams that serve at CDE and Honduras.



Casa de Ester / Honduras Itinerary (tentative) - 2019

- Sat., Jan. 12 Depart San Antonio, Texas and travel to Casa de Ester in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. Spend the afternoon/evening getting to know the girls.
- Sun., Jan. 13 Attend worship at a nearby church with the CDE family. The afternoon is spent introducing the girls to the weeks schedule of various activities & projects.
- Mon. - Wed., Jan. 14 - 16 These days will be spent on devotional time, projects, activities, & the building of relationships.
- Thurs., Jan. 18 The morning will include devotional time & project instructions for the girls to work on. The STM team will enjoy a time of rest & time to bless the local vendors. Our day will end visiting the girls of CDE Casa Legado.
- Friday, Jan. 19 - This day will be devoted to devotional time, completing of projects & activities. We will end the evening with a closing night of sharing & praises as a recap of our week long service.
