Trip Details:
Total Trip Cost: \$1,900

Land Cost: \$950. All inclusive of meals, lodging, in-country transportations, insurance, interpreters, bottled water, sightseeing, ministry supplies, etc.

Airfare Cost: \$950 OHC MUST arrange all Airfare travel.

Place of Stay:
The team will stay at CDE. The Mission Home is located on the grounds of CDE, adjacent to the main CDE home. Beds are bunk style, with restroom/shower, and a small kitchen area. We will take all our meals (all buffet style) with the CDE girls at the main house.

Trip Orientation/Meetings:
We will have several Team meetings prior to our trip. We will provide you with a Team Informational Packet at the 1st Team Meeting. Team Meetings are required and will focus on building team unity, learning about the culture of our designated country, discuss & plan for our in-country service.

In December 2016, the Perry's transitioned state-side to focus on building their ministry partnership network, along with fundraising and continue to be involved with the operations of CDE and participate with STM teams that serve at CDE and Honduras.

- Sat., Jan. 11 Depart San Antonio, Texas and travel to Casa de Ester in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. Spend the afternoon/evening getting to know the girls.
- Sun., Jan. 12 Attend worship at a nearby church with the CDE family. The afternoon is spent introducing the girls to the weeks schedule of various activities & projects.
- Mon. - Wed., Jan. 13 - 15 These days will be spent on devotional time, projects, activities, & the building of relationships.
- Thurs., Jan. 16 The OHC team will enjoy a time of rest & shopping. We will end our day visiting the girls of CDE Casa Legado.
- Friday, Jan. 17 This day will be devoted to devotional time, completing of projects & activities. We will end the evening with a closing night of sharing & praises as a recap of our week long service.

What will we do at Casa de Ester?

The majority of our time is spent at CDE; on Thursday evening, our team will spend a few hours of fellowship with the girls of Casa Legado, an extension of CDE for those girls who are working / going to school from their downtown home.
