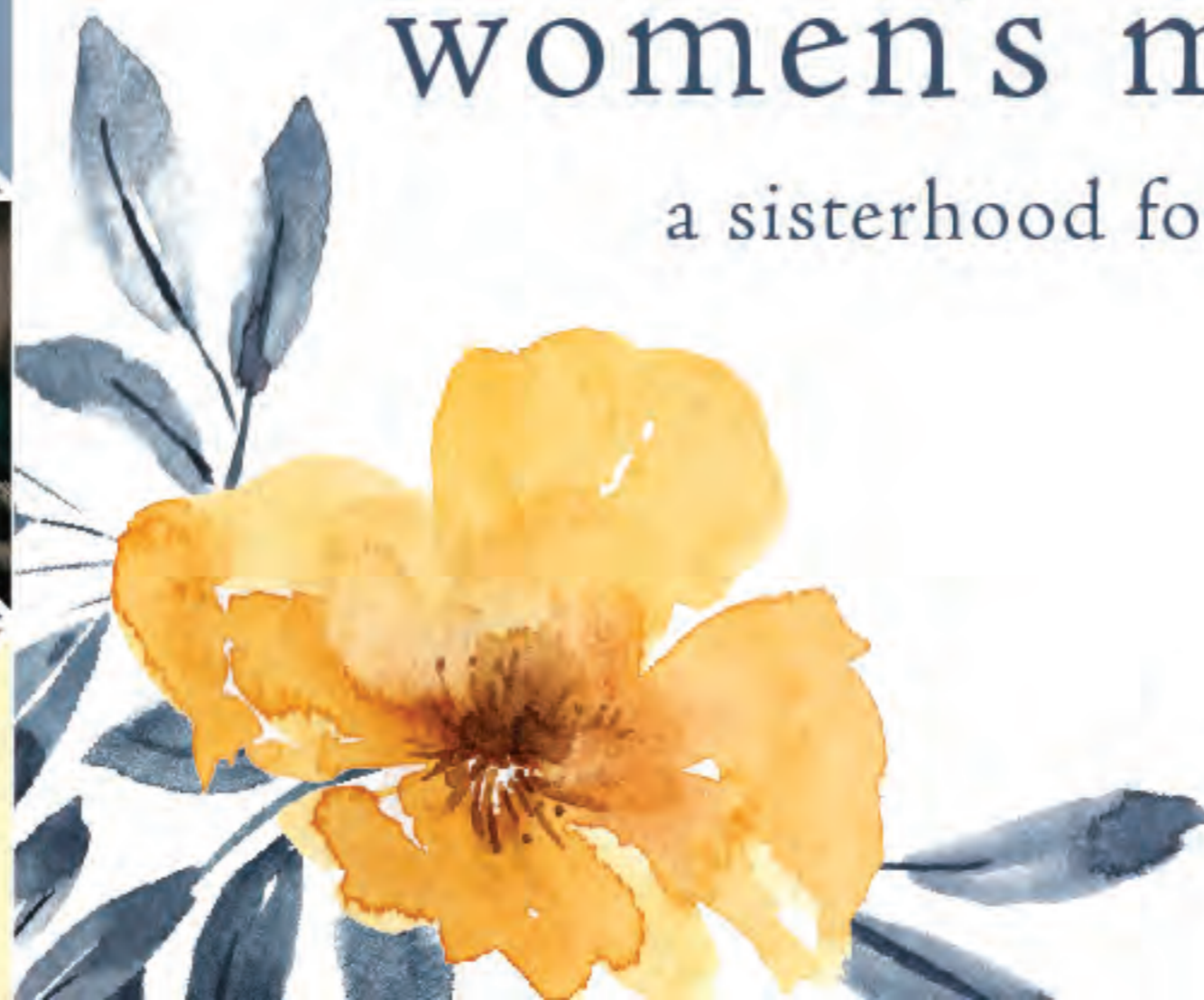
MOMS IN PRAYER GROUP:
