

# SERMON NOTES

**A New Way to Look at Cemeteries**

**November 10-11, 2018**

**Awestruck**

**John 19:38-20:18**

1. The men who served the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ.

Later, Joseph of Arimathea asked Pilate for the body of Jesus. Now Joseph was a disciple of Jesus, but secretly because he feared the Jewish leaders. With Pilate's permission, he came and took the body away. He was accompanied by Nicodemus, the man who earlier had visited Jesus at night. Nicodemus brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about seventy-five pounds. Taking Jesus' body, the two of them wrapped it, with the spices, in strips of linen. This was in accordance with Jewish burial customs. At the place where Jesus was crucified, there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb, in which no one had ever been laid. Because it was the Jewish day of Preparation and since the tomb was nearby, they laid Jesus there.

(John 19: 38-42 NIV)

2. The woman who heard the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ.

Early on Sunday morning, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance. (John 20:1 NLT)

3. The follower who believed in the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ.

Then the other disciple, who came to the tomb first, went in also; and he saw and believed.

(John 20:8 NKJV)
